Report Summary

The draft results show net expenditures of \$238,550 which is similar to last year (\$231,899) and over budget (\$220,371) by \$18,179. Reports are draft as we are still waiting on ARIS reports to complete billing.

In 2023, Chatsworth transferred \$78,869 to Arran-Elderslie. The Chatsworth portion of the 2023 full year actuals is \$87,180. Therefore, the final year-end adjustment results in a requirement of Chatsworth to transfer \$8,311.

Please refer to the appendix Board Report – Chesley and Area Joint Fire Board, December 31, 2023, for more details.

Background

Historically, the Chesley Fire Station budget would be presented to the Joint Fire Board prior to the budget being presented to Arran-Elderslie's Council. This was not the case for 2024. On February 26, 2024 the final 2024 Operating and Capital Budget, inclusive of the Chesley Fire Station was presented to Council and passed unanimously.

Analysis

Revenues

Revenues came in at \$56,208 which is similar to last year (\$57,416) and over budget (\$46,658) by \$9,550. User Fees were less than budget and last year due to less incidents. More than anticipated donations (Other Revenue) - \$17,070 actuals that were not budgeted..

Expenses

Total expense actuals are \$294,758 which is greater than budget (\$267,029) by \$27,729, but similar to 2022 actuals (\$289,315). Large variances are shown below.

Wages – The Fire Chief's actual salary and benefits were split to show the portion for Chesley. This split was not in the budget. However, less incidents led to less spending on wages.

Projects & Initiatives (account 4660) \$9,718 but no budget. As a result of the donations received, we had several purchases including a rescue saw and thermal cameras.

Tanker expenses were incurred of \$9,578 vs a budget of \$1,717 and 2022 actual of \$3,439. Variance is mostly due to a pump that needed to be purchased in 2023.

Rents and Financial expenses (Write-offs) of \$17,007 but no budget. Write Off's are not budgeted. In 2023, a matter was settled and we some aged invoices were written off.

Other Transfers - \$2,842 vs budget of \$16,225 – fewer common expenses than budgeted.

<u>2024 Budget</u>

Arran-Elderslie Council has approved the 2024 Budget which is similar to the 2023 budget with adjustments for inflation. Please see details attached in Appendix B.

Pumper Truck

A replacement pumper truck is required by the end of 2025 / beginning of 2026. The estimated cost to replace is \$760,000. Some suppliers require customers to purchase chassis first. Currently, the lead times are over one year.

Therefore, \$190,000 was identified in the 2024 Capital Budget and \$570,000 will be presented in the 2025 Capital Budget. The Township of Chatsworth is required to commit to paying \$260,680 (\$760,000*34.3%) over the 2024 -2026 period.

The 2023 year end is almost final and the draft version presented shows actual net expenditures \$18,179 over budget (but similar to 2022 actuals). 2024 Budget is higher than 2023 budget due to inflation.

Recommendation

- Approve the recommendation that the Interim Treasurer bring forth a budget plan for the purchase of a new Pumper Truck to Arran-Elderslie and Chatsworth Councils; and
- 3. Create a sub-committee for the preparation of a RFP for a Pumper Truck to replace the 2005 Pumper 91 in Chesley.

Report Summary

The intent of this report is to bring the Chesley & Area Joint Fire Board up to date with the status of the Chesley and Area Station 90 for 2023, and to provide information on the purchase of a new Pumper Truck for Chesley Station 90.

<u>Background</u>

The following information is comprised of Fire Responses, Training, Apparatus Information, Fire Prevention and Public Education completed for the year 2023.

Regarding the replacement of the 2005 Pumper Truck, it should be noted that Chief Bell, prior to Chief Tiernan being hired at the end of 2021, had advised the Fire Board, that, in following the previous plan with replacement of frontline pumper apparatus within the Municipality, a pumper truck would be required in 2025.

In following the replacement plan, this would allow the Municipality to keep their frontline pumpers as graded apparatus with regards to the Fire Underwriters Surveys grading system for Municipal Fire Protection.

Analysis

Completed analysis of information for January to December 2023, obtained from Chesley Fire Station 90 statistics:

- Sixty-Eight (68) incidents in 2023 compared with eighty-one (81) in 2022
- Fifty-Six (56) Arran-Elderslie, Twelve (12) Chatsworth

The total breakdown of fire calls is identified within "Appendix A"

Summary of Training

Throughout 2023, training continued to be focused on Mandatory Certification. Firefighters attended Bruce County Fire School which was held in Tobermory.

In 2024, the Bruce County Fire School will be held in South Bruce Peninsula and will focus on all classes being National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) certified. This is something the Bruce County Fire Chiefs had asked for moving forward.

The following training was conducted throughout March-December:

- Firefighters completed in-house First Aid and CPR recertification.
- Search and Rescue, Low Angle Slope Rescue.
- Search and Rescue within the "smoked-out" training facility located behind the Arran-Elderslie Municipal Office.
- Propane Emergencies with fire attack.
- Kitchen Fires with set up of Porta Tank system.
- Horizontal and Vertical Hydraulic Ventilation using the new smoke machine.
- Auto Extrication with new Auto Cribbing tools.
- Auto Extrication at a local scrap car compound to utilize hydraulic tools.

Firefighters also continued throughout the year to work on the NFPA 1001 Firefighter Level 1 & 2 skills.

Chesley Fire Station had one (1) firefighter challenge the NFPA 1001 Level 1 & 2 exams and skills testing in Markdale, and successfully completed this exam.

Moving into 2024, the firefighters will continue to train towards NFPA 1001 Firefighter 1 & 2 certification, with the goal of having the Chesley Station fully certified to NFPA 1001 Firefighter Level 1 & 2 by the end of 2024.

Emphasis will also be placed on completing their NFPA 1072 Hazmat Awareness and Operations levels as per the mandatory certification.

As part our succession planning, two (2) firefighters were promoted to the roles of Acting Captains.

Captains attended a NFPA 1021 Fire Officer Level 1 course. Chesley Station 90 hosted the class which was well attended.

<u>Tanker Usage</u>

Tanker usage is identified in Appendix "B".

Apparatus Review

Generally, the apparatus has been performing satisfactorily with no major concerns in 2023.

- A new CET portable pump was purchased for Tanker 94.
- Annual pump testing and ladder testing were completed.
- Annual SCBA flow testing has been completed.

Prevention and Inspections

Fire Prevention inspections continue, especially within the commercial downtown core of Chesley. Request and complaint prevention matters are being addressed as concerns are raised.

Public Education

Public Education continues with our social media sites. Fire department staff continue public education throughout the Municipality, daycares, schools as well as visits to the firehalls.
