Recommendation

Report Summary

After eight months, the department is on track to meet the budget, unless fire call numbers increase later in the year.

Background

Arran-Elderslie and Chatsworth split the Chesley Fire Hall revenues and expenses 70% / 30%.

The following accounts are not split (i.e. 100% Arran-Elderslie):

- a) User Fees (incident response revenue);
- b) Inspection revenue and expenses;
- c) Fire prevention expenses; and
- d) Dispatch expenses.

Analysis

Revenues

Revenues are currently \$8,498 above budget projections. All incident response revenue is fully allocated to the Municipality of Arran-Elderslie. The Municipality of Chatsworth issues invoices for any incident responses that occur within its jurisdiction.

Expenses

Salaries and Wages

Salaries and wages are currently under budget. This variance is due to the payment structure for volunteer firefighters, who are compensated annually. The budgeted amount is distributed evenly across each month, resulting in a temporary underspend.

Repair and Maintenance

Year-to-date, repair and maintenance expenses are **\$8,422 over budget**. This overage is primarily attributed to the installation of a new furnace and more comprehensive annual vehicle inspections compared to previous years.

Telephone and Communications

Expenses in this category are **\$5,026 over budget**. The increase is due to the purchase and repair of pagers, ensuring reliable backup communication in the event of cellular service disruptions.

Legal Services

Legal services expenditures are significantly over budget. This is due to a specific legal matter in Arran-Elderslie. All legal service costs incurred in 2025 have been allocated exclusively to Arran-Elderslie.

Inter-Municipal Transfers

In accordance with the established schedule, Chatsworth was invoiced for **25% of the budgeted transfer amount** on **March 31** and **June 30**. The next invoice will be issued on **September 30**, with the final invoice scheduled for early **2026**. The final amount will be **\$8,565**, subject to adjustment based on the actual operating revenues and expenses for 2025.

Pumper Truck

The Municipality anticipates being invoiced for 25% of the chassis cost in 2025, with Chatsworth's portion estimated at \$57,000 plus HST. The remaining balance will be invoiced upon delivery, which is expected in early 2026. The Chatsworth share of the delivery invoice is projected to be \$148,200 plus HST, in addition to any minor additions discussed at the most recent meeting.

Recommendation

Background

This report presents information to the Chesley & Area Joint Fire Board about the status of Chesley and Area Station 90 during the third quarter of 2025 (July to September).

Analysis

The analysis of data collected from Chesley Fire Station 90 for the period July 1st to September 13th has been completed.

- Nine (9) incidents from July 1st to September 13th, 2025, compared with Sixteen (16) in 2024.
- All nine (9) calls in Arran-Elderslie.
- Year-to-date calls for service for Chesley Station 90 41 calls this year. In 2024 Chesley Station 90 received 57 calls for service.

Total breakdown of fire calls is identified within "Appendix A".

Summary of Training

- Firefighters completed their NFPA 1072 HazMat Awareness and Operations certification.
- Firefighters continue to train on mandatory annual skills sign offs.

Apparatus and Equipment Review

- Annual MTO certifications completed.
- Pump and Ladder testing completed.

Prevention and Inspections

- Inspections of commercial businesses through requests and complaints are ongoing throughout the Municipality.
- Public Education Activities continue throughout the Municipality. Monthly news articles are also published on our social media sites.
- Litigation continues regarding two properties in Chesley.
- Firefighters attended the Water Festival in Chesley over three days promoting Fire Safety.
