



2026 Operating Budget highlights Budget planning exercises in September and October focused on ensuring financial responsibility and maintaining service levels, using actual expense data to guide budget estimates.

At Council's requests, staff undertook a further review to confirm these principles and identify additional efficiencies without reducing services


Water fees will increase 3%

Sanitary Sewer fees will increase 3%


Stormwater fees are new and cost the average urban residence \$103 in 2026 – fee varies based on size of property

Municipal property taxes and most user fees will increase by approximately 4.95% - dog tag fee to increase from \$15 to \$20



## THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ARRAN-ELDERSLIE

# By-Law 81-2025 Being a By-law to Confirm the Proceedings of the Special Council Meeting of the Municipality of Arran-Elderslie held November 12, 2025

WHEREAS by Section 5(1) of the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, grants powers of a Municipal Corporation to be exercised by its Council; and

WHEREAS by Section 5(3) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that powers of every Council are to be exercised by By-law unless specifically authorized to do otherwise; and

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the proceedings of the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Arran-Elderslie for the period ending November 12, 2025, inclusively, be confirmed and adopted by By-law.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Arran-Elderslie enacts as follows:

- 1. The action of the Council of the Municipality of Arran-Elderslie at its Special Council meeting held November 12, 2025, in respect to each motion and resolution passed, reports received, and direction given by the Council at the said meetings are hereby adopted and confirmed.
- 2. The Mayor and the proper Officials of the Corporation are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to the said action of the Council.
- 3. The Mayor and Clerk, or in the absence of either one of them, the Acting Head of the Municipality, are authorized and directed to execute all documents necessary in that behalf, and the Deputy Clerk is authorized and directed to affix the Seal of the Corporation to all such documents.

Read a first and second time this 12th day of November, 2025.

Read a third time and finally passed this 12th day of November, 2025.
